35- Resistance Skills –Young person can resist negative peer pressure and dangerous situations
 Having the confidence to say “no” in situations that make you feel uncomfortable can often be a difficult task. Take the time to think about what values are important to you and how you can take a stand in defending them if the situation arises. Having conversation about what to do will make you feel more comfortable if ever confronted with a situation. Talk to your parents about “safety nets” which can be as simple as a code word that alerts them to pick you up so you don't have to get into someone's car that might have been drinking or making you feel unsafe. Make it a goal this month to think about and practice your resistance skill!
