TOURNAMENT RULES & REGULATIONS

TEAM ROSTER:

All teams are required to have four players on their roster except for 50+, they may have 5 players. Roster changes will not be allowed after **Entry Deadline**. No additions and/or substitutions can be allowed after **Entry Deadline**.

ONE ROSTER: Players may appear on only one team roster.

PLAYER ELIGIBILITY: The information provided on the application must be accurate. Players are required to bring ID to the tournament. Example: **Birth Certificate, Lancaster Recreation Photo ID card or Driver License. Players will be checked before and throughout the event.**

LIABILITY WAIVER: Every reasonable effort will be made to ensure the safety and integrity of facilities. However, the Town of Lancaster will not be liable for any loss, injury or death related to your attendance at or participation in the tournament. **All participants (or parents if under age 18), must sign the liability waiver (on the reverse side of this flyer) before they compete.**

TEAM CANCELLATION: Teams dropping out of the tournament after registration form has been received will not receive a refund.

CO-ED TEAMS: All co-ed teams will be placed in the male divisions.

WEATHER: If poor weather conditions occur call the Parks and Recreation Department (684-3320).

SCORING:

- 1.) A field goal is worth 1 point.
 - 2.) A successful goal from behind the "take back" line is worth 2 points. The player shooting must have both feet completely behind the line when initiating the attempt.
 - 3.) A technical/intentional foul shot is worth 1 point.

4.) Games will be played to 20 points - win by 2. There will be a 20 minute maximum time limitation on every game. If time expires, the team in the lead will be awarded the win, or if the score is tied, the next basket wins.

5.) **NO DUNKING ALLOWED!!**

FOULS & VIOLATIONS:

1.) All fouls and violations will be called by the players participating. The **player fouled** is responsible for making the call.

2.) The players' foul and violation calls are considered final, however, in the case of an obvious miscall, the referee may change the call at his/her discretion.

3.) The referee may call a technical foul for the following reasons:

- Unsportsmanlike conduct
- Intentional foul
- Intentional delay of game

OTHER:

1.) All games may start and be completed with any number of players (3,2,1).

2.) Games are scheduled every half hour.

3.) Teams must be at their court at the scheduled time, even if games are "running behind". A five minute forfeit time will be strictly enforced.

4.) The team captain is the sole spokesperson for his/her team.

5.) Referee has the final say. There is no appeal process.

6.) We expect all competitors to exhibit honesty and good sportsmanship in order to preserve the integrity of the game.

7.) The tournament will be double elimination if there are enough teams in each division.
